

School Supplies Needed for 8th Grade

- 1 - large glue stick
- Crayola classic colors markers -washable-thick-8 or 10 colors
- 4 – red ink pens
- 12 – black or blue ink pens – **no erasable pens**
- 1 – box of 24 colored pencils
- 24 - #2 pencils sharpened
- 1 – 12” ruler with metric and inch markings
